COURSE OUTLINE

This unit of competency is a nationally accredited course that provides the skills and knowledge required to monitor the effects of blasting on the environment. It is also an approved course for the application of a Queensland Shotfirers Authority.

This unit of competency covers:

- Developing strategies to control effects of blasting
- Implement environment monitoring systems
- Review strategies to control & ensure effectiveness of blasting operations

TRAINING METHODS

Face to face classroom delivery:

Trainer will be used to facilitate the underpinning knowledge requirements with practical hands on use of the equipment in a simulated environment.

In conjunction with the Open Cut Shotfiring programme:

An additional consecutive face to face classroom training day post open cut shotfiring programme.

Online based:

Participants are enrolled onto DTE training portal which provides access to the learning resources to be complete at your own pace. Trainer is available via email and/or phone conversation to assist with any questions or queries.

ASSESSMENT

Face to face classroom delivery & in conjunction with Open Cut Shotfiring programme:

Both theory and practical assessments will be conducted throughout the course.

Online based:

Participants can complete a theory assessment using the online portal. Practical assessments will require evidence to be uploaded post completion at site.

On successful completion participants receive a Statement of Attainment.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is designed for those who wish to gain future employment as a qualified open cut shotfirer within the quarry and construction sectors.

It is also suitable for those who currently work as a shotfirer and are looking to upskill to broaden job opportunities.

PREREQUISITES

Face to face classroom delivery & Online:

For entry into this unit of competence, participants are required to have previously completed the open cut shotfiring course and must be able to supply evidence of a current security clearance issued by the police which also includes Australia Security Intelligence Organisation checks. Minimum requirement of receipt of application for such security clearance.

Online based:

In addition to the above requirements online completion requires access to a mine site and explosives to complete the practical components of the training.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

Recognition of prior learning is subject to approval once student has met with trainer assessor and sufficient evidence can be presented.
