COURSE OUTLINE

This course is a nationally accredited one day course and is accepted in the mining, construction, oil, gas, and other main stream industries throughout Australia.

The course addresses the need for personnel who issue work permits to understand the permit system, know the limitations of each permit and make decisions regarding the need for and correct use of each permit.

The course is compliant with Australian Workplace Health and Safety Regulations and the Australian Standard for Working in a Confined Space AS/NZS 2865 and covers the following areas:

- Confined space entry permit
- Identify need for work permit
- Conduct hazard analysis
- Prepare work site for authorised work
- Raise and issue work permits
- Monitor work for compliance
- Receive end of day report
- Close work permit

Face to face classroom delivery will be used to facilitate the underpinning knowledge requirements. Practical assessment activities will ensure performance is acceptable with training standards and Industry requirements.

RESPONSIBLE PERSON

Under the Work Health Safety Act and Regulations This is the person in charge or 'responsible' for the whole confined space entry, in other words the permit issuer.

To acquire this position, a person requires this competency, be a competent person within the field the permit is being issued and authorised by the company.

ASSESSMENT

Attendees are required to bring their own permit to work system for use on the day and to be assessed against.

Both theory and practical assessments will be conducted throughout the course.

On successful completion participants receive a Statement of Attainment.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Personnel who are required to issue appropriate permits to work to persons conducting a variety of activities in workplace environments in which hazards exists and/or specific procedures need to be followed and monitored to protect the safety of personnel and the integrity of plant or
